I leave for Egypt about Oct.  
18<sup>th</sup> to work for Dr. Hunt not  
far from Behnesa where I shall  
be for two months. Then I go  
to Amada or Derr for Mespers.  
Jan<sup>y</sup> - April 1<sup>st</sup>. I see much  
of Röder in Kabilia & he  
has been most helpful to me

especially in instructing me in the  
ways of the Department.

I am asking Joyce the secretary  
of the Royal Anthropological  
Society to send you another number  
of "Man" that will contain ~~two~~  
articles, <sup>one</sup> on ~~the~~ ~~sign~~ ~~9~~ & another on Mod.  
Egyptian Folk lore & the sign 9.

I am working especially on the  
Religion now & particularly  
on M. K. Coffins & Pyr. Texts.

I try as much as possible, too, to  
find out any survivals of old  
ideas & beliefs among the Fellahin.  
Last Spring I spent the Month  
En-Nebby in Gueft, in the house  
of the Man responsible for all the  
performances in honour of the  
Prophet.

I am afraid you will not know  
who I am, but I was Mr. Saffith's
