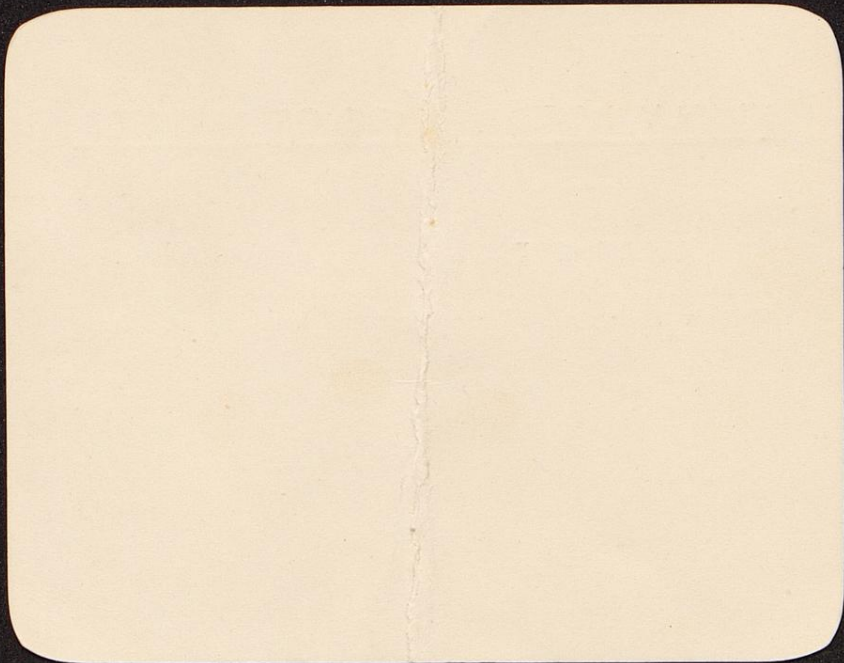

Dear Dr. Egan.

I thank you very much for the copy of Mr. O'Leary which you have so kindly sent to me, and also for your paper on the papyrus of the Book of Proverbs.

I think it only fair to tell you that I have drawn up a little book on the Moral Papyrus and in it I have printed a revised transcript of the Teaching of Ananias, with a ~~copy~~ complete translation and a long introduction. In it most of your corrections of the summary in the Papyrus volume are anticipated, also references are given to the Book of Proverbs. The book will be out next week. If I thought it would be acceptable I would send you a copy, but the remarks made by your friends about me and my work make me hesitate. Criticism I don't mind, but cynical abuse does me good.
