French & German are at present
so confused in my head, that
I don't think it safe to
attempt a letter in either.

I have permitted myself the
pleasure, yesterday, of sending
to Berlin a copy of Carlyle's
"Essays", which I hope you
will accept, — even if you
don't read! I did not

know how I could otherwise
thank you for all the help
you gave me through out the
Easter Vacation, & without
which I should indeed have
regretted my return to
Berlin; for it wd, no doubt,
have been wiser, had I
remained at home somewhat
longer, before returning to
work.

While here, I've tried to
profit by Maspero's lectures
at the "Collège de France";
& find them, so far as I

have been able to be present,
very instructive, especially in
matters of pure archeology;
With the "Pyramide Textes", he goes
very slowly, but will, I hope,
publish, some day, ^{his} "leçons"
on them.

Please excuse so short a letter.
