My dear Emma.

I would have written before this to you, but I owed Peter a letter too and — to tell the truth — a German letter for a child is somewhat of an undertaking; for bad German would be more severely criticised by Peter probably than ~~you~~ by you — & what is more, he would not understand it! But on the other

thanks to him for his Christmas
present, which I much admired.

I have sometimes thought that I might,
as you suggest, undertake a Celtic
Dictionary. But Steindorff has that
in view, I think, has he not? And
he is far more competent. He has
now made an arrangement with
Hinrichs for publishing our *Zweue*
texts — we have about 130 in
all — & when he is back from
Byzant, we shall, I hope, begin.
I think Perillout must have heard of
this: for he is advertising an edition
as being now "sous presse" [He is
indeed advertising 11 works now, as
"sous presse" or "en préparation"!]
