It has been a long time since I wrote to you. We are all well, however, and I often think back upon the delightful time which you and Mrs. Erman gave me in Berlin. I write now to say that I have sent you by this mail proof sheets of the Introductions to Ezekiel and Daniel, comments upon which I am now finishing.
