My dear Erman.

This is the last letter I
shall write you from this house.
We have just sold it and
have removed to

The Chestnuts.

Aldeburgh Suffolk,

which will be my address for a
year, at any rate. The change
has been sudden and is owing to

Doctors' orders. They have told me
that I must no longer live in
London, but must go to the
east sea-coast, where the air
is very strong, & where I can
live mostly out of doors. The
reason is that I have devel-
oped a tuberculous (sic!)
gland in the neck, which, they
tell me, must be taken as
serious. It is a great nuisance,
for, although we had meant to
leave London eventually, it is

most inconvenient to be obliged to
do so at once, when many jobs are
still unfinished. Dictionaries at
any rate, can be as well made in the
country as in town, and I hope
to be able to go on with mine,
though progress will be slow, as
I am not allowed to work many
hours a day.

I got the sector's verdict the day
after Doris was here. I hope
she got safely home and that
you had a good Easter holiday?

We have only taken our house at
Aldeburgh for a year, so that

my small nephew may go to a
school there as a "day-boy" for a
little longer. After that, we hope
to leave ~~the~~ him at the school,
as a "boarder", & go ourselves
to some more attractive part of
the country. We have had therefore
to select from this house books,
etc. for the year — a difficult
task — while sending the rest of our
things to be stored, here.

There is a letter all about myself!
Please let me hear a word about
your doings in return.
