Dear Frau Emma

I've been very bad about writing
I'm afraid, but that does not mean
I forget you - I do so hope you
will keep well this summer
& have a happy time - We have
been here just three weeks, and
the weather, which was awful at
first, has been simply glorious
all this last week. I think
Walter has thoroughly enjoyed himself
and he is as brown as a berry, but
I was unlucky enough to get an
intermittent chill almost at once, &
have now quite recovered -
We motored to Looe one day &

went through "Westward Ho," which I had never seen & where your girls were at school - it is unfortunately one of the few dull places on this beautiful coast. Florelly is a sort of stage village, one very steep cobbled street sheer down to the sea, with highly picturesque (but entirely renovated) cottages. The most beautiful place here is Norte Point to which we go nearly every day & take our tea & sit amongst the heather & the sheep, looking across a brilliantly blue sea to the Welsh hills. We go home tomorrow & then to work once more. If W. keeps well now we ought to make real progress, for we've got into our stride now & know exactly what each has to do.
