Dear Professor Sman,

In one hour more I shall be homeward bound, but I stop at Strassburg for a day and a half on the way. I expect to arrive in Berlin early on Thursday morning, and I dare say I shall come to the Museum before it closes. I should like to see you as soon as possible after my return, so I write now to let you know my movements. If you would send a postcard to Matthäikirchstr. telling me when I could call on you, I should be very thankful.

There were no ostraea, apparently, to be studied in Bologna, nor should I have had time for them: it was only possible to study 3 hours a day there; and besides Sunday there was an inevitable Italian "festivo giorno"! Of the latter however I was very glad, as it

enabled me to pay a visit to Ravenna -
interessantississimo!

The last days in Turin brought me a discovery
of some interest - which I think will puzzle
the chronologists. Sethe alone has heard of it,
and he agrees with me that my little bomb is
a "rechtgefährliches Revolutionsmittel." But
of this I will tell you when we meet.
