Sir, I have had much trouble in independent collecting of  
papyrus & venture to ask your assistance on a matter of  
in which I believe you are especially interested. I  
spent a considerable time this year at Siout  
in copying the inscriptions of the four tombs that are  
still extant there.

Before leaving England I examined all the published  
copies of the texts and noted the variations so that  
my attention might be drawn without fail to doubtful  
points.

The texts in the tombs are much damaged & a  
careful examination of them has enabled me to restore  
large portions with certainty. I am very desirous to compare all earlier copies  
that I can find, as the tombs have been considerably  
damaged in the last few years. Tomb II is now quite  
destroyed, but I have been able to correct & restore the  
published inscription from it to a great extent by means
