Dear Sir,

Your letter reached Egypt while I was on a journey to El Arish, & I have further delayed my answer because I fully intended to return by Berlin.

Since reaching Italy however I have found that I cannot spare time for the long journey to Berlin.

I am very glad indeed that you take so much interest in the inscriptions from Siout, & have to thank you for your cordial letter and kind promise of help. I hope to send the plates before very long.

I am sorry to say that there is very little new material from the Heracleopolite tombs & no new names. I have copied those that exist (5 or 6) in the tomb of Haplofa - Ask the reliefs & patterns a friend of mine proposes next year to photograph & study them. W. Petrie has I think photographed a portion of them.

At Paris I shall try to unearth the M.S. copies of Jomville & Devilliers which are perhaps to be found in the Bibliothèque Nationale.
