Dear Sir,

I understand that I may publish any unpublished inscriptions contained in the copies of Démichiel Brugsch. In that case I reckon on your kind assistance in adding them ~~into~~ to the plates when I have drawn them.

As I am beginning to draw the plates, but fear that the additions may overrun the limits I allow in the plates, may I ask you to inform me how much you have of the following inscriptions:

From Tomb II I have copied a fragment of 2 horizontal lines of text beginning  $\overline{\square} \overline{\square}$ , formerly there were more lines.

From Brugsch & De Rougé (cccxxxvi) I have the now destroyed inscription from the inside of the outer doorway (8 vertical lines)
