Dear Mr. Erman,

I was glad to get your letter,
and to hear that you are going
to Egypt. The voyage and the
change will put you into good
condition for carrying on the work
of the Dictionary. You do not
say on what date you will sail.
Perhaps when this letter reaches Berlin
You will have already started. There is

no chance of our getting to Egypt. I
am now taking classes at Owens' College
(Manchester) and afterwards again in
London.

"Hieroglyphs" has been ready for
several weeks, but for some reason it
is being distributed very slowly and
perhaps you will not see your
copy until you come back from
Egypt.

I am looking forward to seeing
the next number of the Zeitschrift
where there is so much of interest

promised for the earliest times.

It seems as if something like
a second centre for Egyptology
will be established at ~~University~~
Owens College. I had 25 to 30
students. Unfortunately they are
all middle-aged or older except
one or two ladies. It is much the
same at University College. The
younger men are completely occupied
with the ordinary curriculum.
But perhaps a few, young and
serious enough to continue, and
eventually to do ~~some~~ original

work, will remain in the
end.
