I am so grieved that you have suffered
this further blow, the loss of your dear
mother. Crum tells me what an admirable
lady she was. You have indeed suffered
heavily in the past year. Let us hope
that a brighter time is now before you
after all your trouble.

You will be grieved to hear that
of my wife's very serious illness,

from which the recovery can only be
very very slow. The illness which
necessitated the operation had
proceeded very far, and neither
she nor the nurse nor we ourselves
had quite realised the necessity
of extreme rest and quiet. She suffers
so much pain. But the symptoms now
happily are improving. A fortnight ago
she was in extreme danger.
