as anything you ever wrote. <sup>one cannot say more!</sup> As yet I  
have only read the last two chapters,  
but I expect to find the earlier ones  
even more interesting, if possible. Has  
any arrangement been made for an  
English translation? It ought to be  
translated at once, and I am sure

I could find a publisher and <sup>a</sup> translator  
if it has not been undertaken already.

Thompson has ~~written~~ written to me of the  
treasures which Schaefer should have  
some of which are being photographed.

He also says that possibly the  
Reinhardt papyrus might be allowed  
to come to England to be studied. I should  
be exceedingly interested to work at it.  
Would you be willing it to be sent to  
England, say to the Rylands Library  
or some other place where it would

be safe? But I could not expect  
work at it before July, and meanwhile  
you may find another student for it.

I believe Peters has found a good  
lot of inscriptions at Sarkul el Khadem  
and I am to edit them for him

Please give my kind remembrances  
to Frau Erman + believe me
