Dear Professor Erman,

I am sending the MS of my
memoir on the Old Nubian Texts
to Schäfer.

When he was here he advised me
to print the glossary which I had
prepared, in full, and I should
much prefer to do so. But when
this is done I fear that the limit
of 130 pages will be passed. I have
therefore marked various portions of
the MS which might be omitted,

namely pp [less important tests
73-75, 79, 83-85, 89-95,]
[grammar
100-118] of the "typoscript" and
the Indexes II, III in MS.

Of these I could best spare pp. 94-5
and 100-118. Some of the matter in
100-118 I should like to condense
into a new page or two,

I believe that two plates only
will be sufficient illustration,
as photographs of the important
tests can be purchased at Berlin
by students.

As the number of plates is so small
it has occurred to me that the
Academy might be willing to
increase the number of pages
by a few.

Would it be possible to commence
printing the main portion of the
memoir at once, leaving the
doubtful portions to be decided
about ~~when~~ at the convenience of
the Academy?

I shall go to the Sudan again
in October and should be very
glad if it were possible to see the

proofs before.

I have at last a new pupil in Egyptian, and am beginning to read with him. He knows a good deal to start with, and it is a great pleasure to re-commence Egyptian, especially as it takes me through the unexplored beauties of your Third Edition!

My wife and I send our greetings to yourself and Frau Erman and all whom we have met at Dahlem.
