My dear Erman,

You will remember that in 1926 my wife and I came to Berlin to examine Lepsius' squeezes of the demotic graffiti at Philae, and the Dodecaschoen<sup>is</sup> generally. You and the staff at the Museum were as friendly and helpful as possible, and finally the squeezes were actually deposited with us for study. Since then we have spent a large part of our time in adding to the collection and preparing the results for publication. Now at length, after many delays, arrangements have been practically completed for their publication in the Temples Immergés, and the printing is to be done by the Clarendon Press here.

The lithograph plates are all ready, 70 large folio plates, some of them double. But I much desire to add ten photographic plates; the photographs of the Berlin expedition (Junker) cannot be improved upon, and I therefore beg you to obtain for me the permission of the Academy to reproduce the following:-
