you about the underground
electric railway commonly
called 'the Tube' which runs

under Oxford Street and
carries passengers very quietly
from the West so that we
can reach the Museum in
less than half an hour from
this house -

If you cannot get lodging
quite near the Museum it
is well to remember this
new means of conveyance.

Crum is going away but I
must remain during the weeks

in London until the end of
September, spending the
Sundays out of town

I hope that we shall persuade
you to go to my native
country for one Sunday when
you cannot look at the
Museum - My brother will
be delighted to take you
down to Somerset & you
will be able to see if the place
will suit your daughters
