Many weeks have passed since  
you were so kind as to send me  
the paper upon the progress of  
the Dictionary - Quern told me  
at Aldeburgh, when I went to  
spend a few days with him,  
how interesting it was & I was  
much gratified to receive a copy  
& I know quite enough of 'the  
swamp' to appreciate all that

you say - I told Boesen at  
Leiden of your graceful name  
for the venerable Egyptian language  
& he was much delighted by  
the accurate designation, which he  
endorsed in the most sympathetic  
manner. I can only bid you  
take courage & believe in the admiration  
which you inspire in your friends  
for the services which you are rendering  
to the science of Language.

I am nearly ready to send some  
copy to the Oxford Press, being now

occupied in correcting the earlier  
written sheets according to the  
method which was followed in the  
later part of the apparatus -

I shall publish the Gospels first  
as before & wait for possible  
accessions of text from Vienna

in order to complete the Acts &  
Epistles - Petric brought a few

new verses this season of early  
writing but he does not give much  
hope of finding any more in the  
same locality - Hyvernat does

not hold out much hope of  
discoveries in America - He & Chubb  
were photographing diligently for their  
Corpus at the Museum last week  
He said that he had not seen you  
at Berlin

I had the great happiness of receiving  
my brother yesterday on his return  
from New Zealand & Australia &  
with his compliments to you he tells me  
to say that he found the Instructor  
in Art of the Technical College at Sydney  
making a dictionary of Egyptian.  
Perhaps you know about this fellow worker  
With my heartiest greetings to you all believe me
