This work presents us for the first time with a connected history of the life and labours of Buddhaghosa the most distinguished commentator of the Theravāda school of Buddhism. Some interesting topics connected with Buddhaghosa have been fully and systematically discussed, e.g., Life of Buddhaghosa—Legends about Buddhaghosa—Origin and Develop-

ment of Buddhist Commentaries—Buddhaghosa's works—Successors of Buddhaghosa—Encyclopædic character of Buddhaghosa's works—Philosophy of Buddhaghosa—Buddhaghosa's interpretation of Buddhism. This monograph must be in the hands of every student of Ancient Indian history as without it the study of the Buddhist period remains incomplete.

The perusal of this volume will certainly be accompanied by a profitable acquisition of a comprehensive knowledge of the eschatology of popular Buddhism.
