You may remember  
that when we met  
in London last August  
I spoke to you about  
Ancient Egyptian Geo-  
graphy. I believe a  
useful source of informa-  
tion exists in the names  
of the subdivisions of the  
villages. These bear  
names which are often

not arabic, & which I  
believe often contain  
the older Coptic, Greek,  
or Egyptian names of  
places which have  
disappeared or which  
have been amalgama-  
-ted with other villages.  
I am sending these  
to other Archaeologists  
also in case they may  
be of use to them in their  
studies, & possibly you  
too may be interested

in them.
