Dear Professor Eaman

I am sorry to tell you that Mr Faulkner will not be able to go to Berlin after all. The police of Berlin refuse permission for him to stay there for the length of time that he wishes, so he has been obliged to make other arrangements for this summer. I hope however that next year he will try again, & we shall then apply for permission through the authorities of this College. It is a pity that Govt officials should prevent the work of a serious student. When we get the permission & the matter is really settled, I will then write, as you suggest, to Prof. Schäfer & ask him to be kind enough to allow Mr Faulkner to work in the Museum & on the Dictionary.
