Dear Professor Erman:

We have been asked by the Commissioner of Internal Revenue to supply further information in connection with the gift made to the Egyptian Dictionary Commission by Mr. John D. Rockefeller, Jr., in the year 1925, and which was claimed as a deduction by him on his Gift Tax return for said year.

The Commissioner has requested the following information from your Commission:

1. Copy of your articles of incorporation, or charter, if you are incorporated.
2. Copy of your constitution, if any, and by-laws, whether incorporated or not.
3. Also an affidavit showing in detail the actual operations of the Commission.

We are therefore asking you to furnish us the above data in order to enable the Commissioner to determine the deductibility of the gift to your Commission for Gift Tax purposes.

In sending the material to me, I will be glad, if possible, to receive duplicate copies so that one copy can be forwarded to the Commissioner of Internal Revenue and the other placed in our tax files.
