Dear Sir

I have been collecting  
all the information I can find  
about the connections between  
Aey & Cyprus I have found in  
a paper "The Owl" Xicoria  
pub<sup>d</sup> Sept 29. 1888. a short  
note on this subject in which  
you say that the "similarity  
between the names Asebi &  
Sebinai is not so great as to

as to justify us in considering  
them as simple variations of  
the same name." & Again

"To the present date in the older  
Egyptian inscriptions, no reference  
to Cyprus has yet been discovered  
- - - - on the official inscriptions,  
unless Cyprus is included in the  
general term "Islands of the Sea"  
or referred to under one of the many  
names not yet deciphered".

This is the only view possible  
on the strength of the information  
I have been able to find, but  
might I ask whether this is  
still your view, or whether you

have found anything fresh to cause  
you to change your opinion?

I should like to publish a copy  
of your note, & if it still holds  
good, it would strengthen my  
argument considerably if I  
might say so.
