My dear Prof. Loman.

I have delayed answering your kind letter until now because I had received no official authorization to receive the order so graciously given to me by H.M. the German Emperor. But now I have received a letter from our Government asking for the small fees necessary on these occasions, and I suppose in due course the matter will be settled.

Thank you so very much for your share in giving me this honour, which I greatly appreciate. Please remember that I am always willing to give you any assistance in my power, and to act as your unofficial agent in Egypt in any matter you care to put into my hands. I do not think that I need explain my whole-hearted adherence to the school of Egyptology of which you are the leader.

Gardiner is still with me, and leaves next week. We have been working very hard on our list of Theban tombs - 230 in number now.
