My dear Mr Professor,

I cannot tell you how pleased I was to have your kind letter. It was so good of you to find time to write. I know how very busy you are. Thank you so much for the paper you send me. I am so glad to have it. I wish I could be in "Kolleg" and do the Tell-Amanna inscriptions - I always regret I did not

persevere with the Pyramid Texts, though I
it really was very hot at that time -
The house must indeed be quiet now -
one thing you do not tell me - how
poor Henri's lessons get on - they used
to be not up to the mark sometimes;
but German education is hard on
those who are not born-students - &
possibly Henri is not one - I was always
a little sorry for him.

I have ~~had~~ much to do since I left Germany

last May. I was met when I reached
England by the news that my brother was
ill, and he lived only ten days more.
My sister also died in September, so
now I am quite alone, and have settled
down near Gloucester, where I have so
many friends. I could do no reading
at all for sometime, but am much better
now, and am busy with Ptahhelep -
the Pruse - British Museum MSS - the
man certainly gives ample scope for my

besetting sin of guessing. I hope to go
this winter to Egypt. • to have a
month or so at Thebes. Dr. & Mrs
Gardiner are both going. I have seen
them lately in their new home, &
met Professor Sethe there.

Please give my love to Frau Aman. I
wonder whether she does as much
beautiful work as she used to do. Perhaps
she has not so much time as when
there were three daughters at home.
