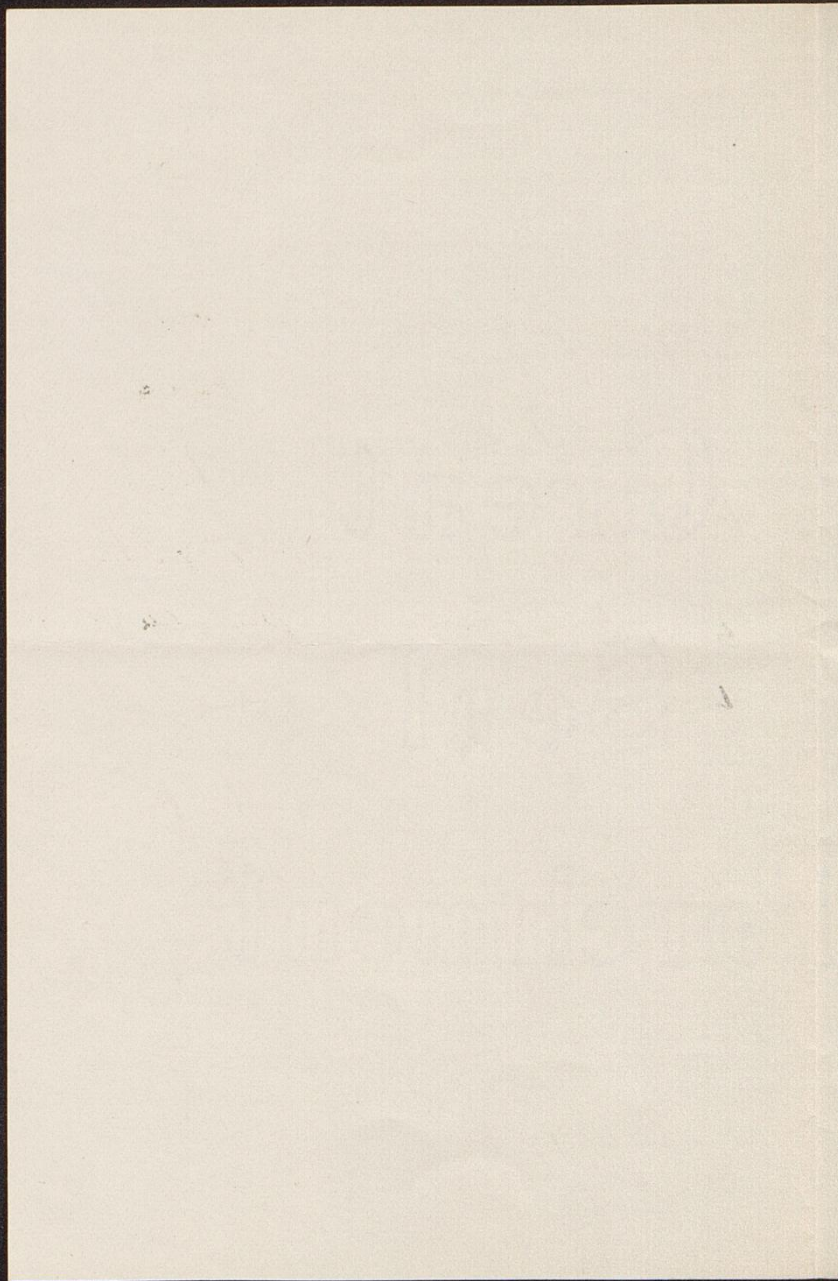


Bullitt College Oxford
